Member of Parliament from Khamdang Ramjar Constituency resigns

Honorable Member of Parliament Kuenga Loday from Khamdang Ramjar constituency, Trashiyangtse has submitted his resignation to the Hon'ble Speaker on 15th November 2021. The Hon'ble Speaker after close discussion with the MP has accepted the resignation on the same day.

The relieving order has been handed over to Hon'ble Kuenga Loday today over a simple ceremony in the presence of the Cabinet Ministers, Leader of the Opposition, Members of the National Assembly, Director and Division Heads of the National Assembly Secretariat.

Hon'ble Kuenga Loday served as the Member of Parliament for three years. As a Member of Parliament, he has actively participated in parliamentary discussions and has served in various parliamentary committees. He has also been active in monitoring the development activities in his constituency. He is a humble person and collaborates very well with other colleague MPs.

The National Assembly of Bhutan expresses deep regret on the early resignation and conveys prayers and best wishes to Hon'ble Kuenga in his future endeavours.

Upon the acceptance of the resignation by Hon'ble Speaker, the seat of the Khamdang Ramjar Constituency is declared vacant. The Speaker has issued a writ to the Election Commission of Bhutan to fill the vacancy.
