PRESS RELEASE

The Tenth Session of the Third Parliament of Bhutan is scheduled from 1 - 20 October 2023.

The Session will be deliberating on the following:

- Agreement on Movement of Traffic-in-Transit between the People's Republic of Bangladesh and the Royal Government of Bhutan and the Protocol thereto
- Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) Charter
- 3. Convention on the Right of Persons with Disabilities and
- 4. Biological Corridor Nine Bill of Bhutan

In addition to the above Bills and international instruments, the House will be deliberating on the implementation status of the resolutions passed in the previous session (9th), review report of the Anti-Corruption Commission's Annual Report 2022-2023, Public Accounts Committee's review report on the Performance Audit Reports and Prime Minister's Annual Report on the state of the nation, including legislative plans and the annual plans and priorities of the Government.

Sittings will also be allocated to move motions, and as per procedure, Question Hour Sessions are scheduled on Tuesdays and Fridays.
